本会の英文誌「The Transactions of the Iron and Steel Institute of Japan」は海外で広く読まれ、名実ともに一流の国際学術雑誌になりました。また最近では海外からの投稿もふえ、本誌の海外における評価が高いことを示しております。皆様の活発なご投稿をおすすめする次第であります。

1. 英文誌には会員も非会員も自由に投稿できます。
2. 総合報告 (Review) は依頼原稿によりますが、研究報告 (Research Article) および研究速報 (Research Note) は全くの自由投稿ですから、どしどしご投稿下さい。
3. 他の雑誌 (「鉄と鋼」以外の雑誌も含む) に和文のみで公表した論文は、改めて英文で本英文誌に投稿することができます。
4. 会員は極めて低廉な追加会費で本誌を購読することができますから、多数の会員の購読をおすすめいたします。

Instructions for Contributors

1. The TRANSACTIONS OF THE IRON AND STEEL INSTITUTE OF JAPAN (Trans. ISIJ) is an official publication of The Iron and Steel Institute of Japan, devoted to papers describing original works in the field of metallurgy, centering on iron and steel, from ore handling to metals science.

2. Of the several categories provided, the Research Article, the Research Notes (including written discussion), and the Report (that describes, for example, novel developments experienced in operating plants) are open to general contributors, whether they are the members of the ISIJ or not, the requisite being the paper not published before except in Japanese.

3. The Editorial Committee of Trans. ISIJ reserves the ultimate right of acceptance or of request for amendments.

4. Papers should be written in English. The criteria for acceptance are the importance in contribution to the science or technology of metallurgy, the originality in idea or method, and the quality with regard to arrangement, clarity, and brevity.

5. The length of a Research Article should be ten printed pages, or approximately 10000 words, at the most, and for Research Notes two pages, or 2000 words, at the most, both including spaces for illustrations and tables

6. Manuscripts should be typewritten double-spaced with wide margins (at least 3cm) on white paper of good quality, using one side of the sheet only. The original and one copy, each complete with title page including author's name, institution or company, and address, (500 words maximum), tables, figures, photographs, list of captions of figures and photographs, and reference list, should be sent to:

Tables, figures (graphs, drawings, and such), and photographs (optical or electron photomicrographs, photographic illustrations, and such) should be separately numbered (e.g. Table 1, Fig. 1, Photo. 1), and accompany the text. Each sheet should contain one table, one figure, or one (group of) photograph(s). Figures and photographs should be in such size and clarity as to be reduced to either 8cm (type A) or 17cm (type B) in width when ultimately reproduced. The reduction type, either A or B, and the original magnification for photomicrographs, should be specified.

References cited in the text should be consecutively numbered and be listed on a separate sheet in the order of numbering. The style should be, for example: 1) J.S.T. van Aswegen, R.W.K. Honeycombe, and D.W.W. Warrington: Acta Met, 12 (1964), 1; 2) C. Wagner: Thermodynamics of Alloys, (1952), 51, Addison Wesley Press, Mass.

7. Only those manuscripts that were judged unsuited for publication in the Trans. ISIJ by the Editorial Committee will be returned to the author.

8. Twenty copies of the reprint will be given to the author(s) free of charge. Additional copies must be paid for in units of fifty.
